



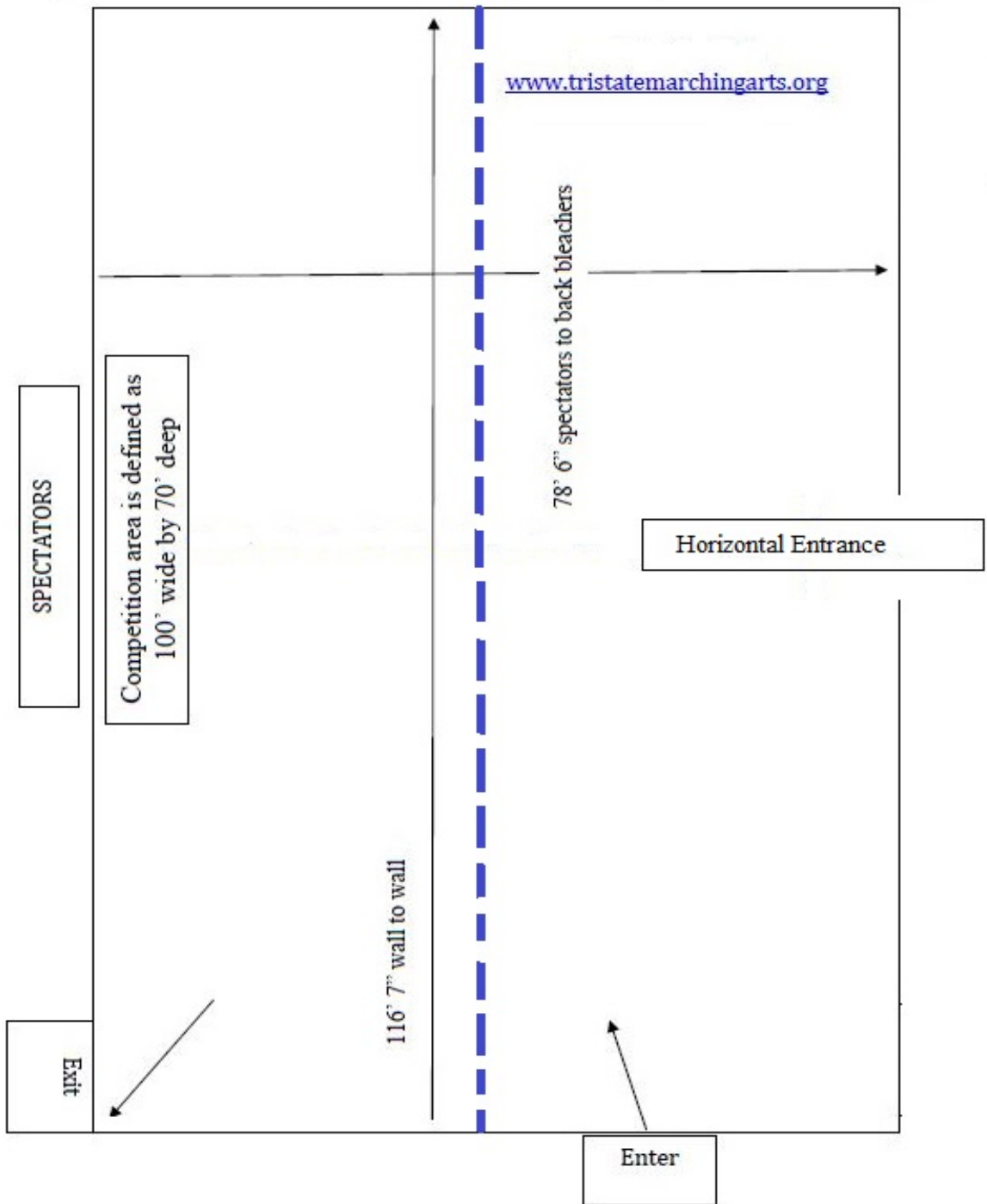
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| <b>Place:</b>                          | Corydon Central HS  |
